



Obiki-no-Hana Viewing Platform

You can enjoy the panoramic view of the Japan Sea from 50 meters above sea level. Sakai, Kasumi-ku **0796-36-1234**



A 270-degree large panorama of the Japan Sea can be viewed.

This is certified as one of the "100 Best Sunsets in Japan", so you can enjoy the view of the sunset.

Obiki-no-Hana Viewing Platform located at a precipitous cliff at 50 meters above sea level. You can view the Japan Sea from there. Leisurely watching the ships coming and going at the horizon with the repetitive rhythmical sounds of waves as a background on a fine day is recommended. You will be overwhelmed by

glorious nature while watching the waves hitting the cliffs. This beautiful landscape is worth preserving. This valuable geographical feature of Kami Town including Obiki-no-Hana is certified as one of the UNESCO Global Geoparks.

The islands floating in the Kasumi Coastline, and the sunset shining on the water surface in purple. Its colors and composition like a painting make you lose track of time.

Yunagi Hill is the place where we recommend you to come for just one purpose. It is a superb view point which was selected as one of the "100 Best Sunsets in Japan". The sky changes from blue to red, and the surroundings turn purple due to its reflection to the water surface. You will definitely be soothed by these sights. After dusk, fishing fires and stars magically illuminate the surroundings in summer. Indulge yourself in a luxury time by lying on the lawn and just by looking at the sights of the Kasumi Coast changing over time.


Landscapes characteristic to Kami Town now and then

The Amarube Railway Bridge Sora no Eki (the sky station), is a must-visit place whether you are a railway enthusiast or not. Get on the Amarube Crystal Tower observation elevator. A magnificent view of the Japan Sea spreading in front of you inspires your heart. Shortly, you will arrive at 41 meters above the ground! A contrast created by the sea, sky and mountains will be etched into your mind. Having enjoyed the view from the top, look up to the viaduct from the ground. Take a good look at its grand view that makes you hold your breath, as well as its structure exuding its presence, and its beauty.



Observation facility, Amarube Railway Bridge Sora no Eki (the sky station)

This is an observation facility built, using bridge piers of the former Amarube Railway Bridge. 1723-4 Amarube, Kasumi-ku 0796-20-3617



The former Amarube railway bridge was built in 1912 and was called the best trestle bridge in the East. It was replaced with the current reinforced concrete bridge in 2010. Illuminations of the Crystal Tower that change the colors by season after dusk is spectacular.






Kusube Valley

As a cradle of the sea, this tidal flat emits various scents of the seashore and makes the visitors feel nostalgic as if they had visited there before. A scent of the mother sea might remind people of a memory of life.




Kaeruiima Island


Shiokaze Koen Park (sea breeze scent park)

Shrines and Temples


Go hiking in fresh green to feel close to the waterfalls and the mountains!


