OJIRO-Hyogo-Kami cho-A beautiful village K ami-cho is located in Tajima in the northern part of Hyogo prefecture, surrounded by mountains and terraced rice-fields. The name, "Ojiro", derives from (小代) which translates to "small rice-fields".

Ojiro town used to be called Mikata town until March 2005 when it was merged with Kasumi and Muraoka towns.

"Ojiro-dani", the valley in the town, which formed the Yadagawa river running from the middle of the city to the Northern area, was featured as "One town, one valley", which means one valley is entirely in one town. "And thanks to this geological


feature; the Japanese cattle breeding has been making great progress.


O jiro:Japanese Wagyu and Mikata-Zankoku Marathon

Ojiro has organized a lot of activities to help maintain its landscapes, environments and culture for the future generations: the hometown of Wagyu and Mikata-Zankoku (challenging) Marathon, organized by the local community, is one of it's activities that has led Ojiro to be recognized as one of "the beautiful villages in Japan" by NPO, a non profit organization which protects the landscapes, environments and cultures in the farm and mountain villages in Japan and has certified Ojiro since October 2012.



The Origin of Japanese Beef - Ojiro

The Pride of People in Ojiro having Lived with Cattle



Ojiro Guide Club members tell the stories about Ojiro, such as the history of Tajima Beef.



History

Tajiri Matsuzo: the man who raised the legend cattle "Tajiri-go" X Tajiri-go: the origin of Japanese Beef

- Tajiri-go was born at the house of Tajiri Matsuzo, the owner of Tajiri 's mother, "Fukue".
- Tajiri-go bred about 1,500 cattle during 13 years, and they and their descendants were taken to the localities of Japanese Beef such as Miyazaki, Hida, Matsuzaka, and Yonezawa and improved the quality of Japanese Beef.
- According to research by the Japan Wagyu Registry Association in February 2012, 99.91% of the Japanese Beef in Ojiro is the descendant of Tajiri-go.
- ●99.9% of all Japanese mother Beef is under the family line of "Tajiri-go", which is called the legend of Japanese Beef".
- Matsuzo was awarded the great prize in 1926 by the Japanese government in recognition of his success in producing Tajiri-go.

The history of Tajima cattle.



The miracle story of the key person,

Maeda Shusuke,

who had been loving cattle, and the legend cattle.

About two hundred years ago, there was a little boy, Syusuke Maeda, who was born in the small village Inotani, Ojiro, and he really loved cattle. One day he knew that the cow he really loved was about to be sold. He looked at the cow being taken somewhere and felt really sad and thought "Why do people sell such a nice cow?"



As time passed by, Syusuke became a great cowherd. He was really smart and could tell if the cattle were good or not. One day, he took four cattle to the market in Osaka, which is far away from Ojiro by 150 km. His cattle got high evaluations and were sold at high prices. He was really happy and thought, "it might be better to live in Osaka".



• However, he changed his mind when seeing the people in Ojiro working hard and their lives were not so affluent.

He thought the best way to help people in Ojiro was to have good cattle and sell them at good prices.

He made up his mind, "I'll definitely make the best cattle for the people of Ojiro!" He spent his parents' money and even owed relatives' money to buy cattle whenever he found good ones.

Finally, his family abandoned him and he became alone. However, he still walked around Ojiro to find good cattle and recorded details about all cattle in Ojiro. He knew that good cattle were born from good cows. "In order to keep the best cattle in Ojiro, I have to find the excellent cow as the origin of Ojiro 's cattle. He walked around not only in Ojiro but in other areas to find good cattle. It took so many years.



At the age of 53, he encountered the best cow in Muraoka, which is next to Ojiro.

"This is the very best one I have ever seen!" Finally, he found it!. This cow became the origin of "Ojiro Beef" which is called "Tajima Beef" now. This great cow could breed great cattle which had their splendid features and went on to the following generations.



This was how the splendid family line of cattle "Tsuru-ushi" was made. His efforts made a lot of good cattle and they were so famous that they were sold at high prices.

Shusuke made the origin of Tajima Beef for his whole life. His strong passion for Ojiro and for the cattle as well as his great efforts made "Tajima Beef" what it is today.

Ojiro Guide Club was organized by the local people. They cooperate with the local stock farmers to introduce the attractions in the most beautiful village in Japan, Ojiro, for the purposes of having visitors know the root of the origin of Japanese Beef, Tajima Beef. They hold tours, take seminars about how to host international visitors regularly, and advertise Ojiro to increase the number of Ojiro s upporters. Getting involved with many people, they feel the deep Ojiro.

The Mikata-Zankoku Marathon Tournament is a yearly tournament held in June in Ojiro. Participants make up twice the total population of Ojiro and come from all over the country. All of them gather to take on the challenge and dominate the courses with significant elevation differences. This challenge would not be so impressive without the warm and welcoming support of the local residents of that region. This event is organized with the collaboration of many volunteers, including high school and junior high school students, all of them cheering for the participants as well. This is a big challenge for a small village, but it's run every year with a huge success. 86 Recently, the number of participants has kept on increasing, making it more and more famous every year. You can see it in about autumn at Yoshitaki Camp Ground area.



and "Silver Fall". They look like as if gold and silver dust are glittering.



In Mt. Utukura cave, Asakura Takakiyo was described by the Minamoto clan as a stiff-necked man, lived in hiding. A number of artifacts have also been excavated.

When the Heike clan was defeated by the Genji clan at the Battle of Ichinotani (1184), Asakura Takakiyo was chased away by the Genji clan for being a burden to the Heike clan and lived in hiding in this Uchikura cave. Eventually, he was forgiven by Yoritomo and ruled over the whole of Tajima, and the Echizen Asakura clan is descended from this family. The course is a 2-hour hike.

Gououzan Koyasan Komyoji Temple

This is the ancient buddhist temple of Mt. Koya Shingon.On the bell of Komyoji Temple, there is a Tajma cattle in relief.The light of the Buddha that illuminates the world can be seen in the temple, Ushinotama-yama.The radiance of the Buddha steers the world to the bright prospects is clear. Let's train diligently more and more at the Komyoji Temple of Mt. gouou.



"oretachi no buyuden (The story of the brave guys)"

"oretachi no buyuden" is their rice's name.

There are terraced paddy fields, which are considered one of the "best terraced paddy fields in Japan" in Uhe mountain in the area of Nukita, where "tajiri-go" (the prestigious cattle in ojiro) was raised. In spring of 2012, it was found that the old people in charge of cultivation in the terraced paddy fields quit their job because of their age. So 13 young people were worried about losing this beautiful scenery of the terraced paddy fields started to cultivate the fields despite struggling due to their lack of experience. They got together to cultivate the fields after their work and call the rice they made "Oretachi no buyuden". They also donated the rice to the public elementary schools for school lunch. Next year, we will be growing the rice in cooperation with the workcamp, high school students in Ojiro, and other volunteers. The rice made in such a wonderful environment was so good and the story of how the rice was made thanks to the painstaking efforts of the young people were well known that the rice kept its good reputation as time went on.





Souzu-karausu Ojiro rice

The "Souzu-karausu" (water mortar), which uses hydraulic power to polish and mill rice with a mortar, was used in the mountainous areas of Ojiro until around 1955 as a tool that could polish rice over time even with little water. In 2013, 7 school friends, including Mr. Fujii of Hirano, restored the

"Souzu-karausu" by hand, hoping to pass on the tools and lifestyles of the past to future generations.

Using valley water from the mountains, the rice is milled slowly and carefully using a pestle over a period of about 5 days. The rice grown in Ojiro, which is grown in beautiful mountain waters, is grown in its natural state using traditional methods, and is characterized by its gloss and chewy texture. It is popular because it retains the natural sweetness of rice.







International workcamp



We have been accepting students in this "international workcamp" since 1 year after Ojiro was selected as one of the "most beautiful villages in Japan". We have participants from various countries every year, and we aim to create a town where more young people can visit the depopulated village and experience the local life. Activities last about 2 weeks and include interacting with the local elderly people, helping with rice harvesting in terraced rice fields, and creating signboards to promote Ojiro as a tourist destination. The participants got a first-hand experience of what it's like to live in Ojiro, an area filled with nature and beautiful sceneries. They were moved by the warm connections with the local people, and discussed advice for welcoming foreign tourists to Ojiro. This has been a big win for both parties.

TAJIMA Beef

TAJIMA cattle, the origin of popular Japanese beef such as Kobe Beef, Sanda Beef, and Awaji Beef, comes from Ojiro Ojiro. The cattle, "Tajiri-go", was originated from the family line of TAJIMA, which is called "Atuta-zuru", and has been protected without crossbreeding with other types of cattles. 99% of the cow from Kuroge beef is descendant of Tajiri-go, according to the Japanese Black domestic breed of Wagyu cattle by Wagyu Registry Association. Tajima beef has a good quality, which is why Matuzaka beef and Oumi beef are made based on the breeding of Tajima beef. Here is the home of Tajima beef. 
I fell in love with Ojiro and moved here! Migration Experience Tour -Mr. Makoto Kuwabara and Mr. Akane Tajiri








Mizuma Livestock and Mr. Tatsuya Mizuma
